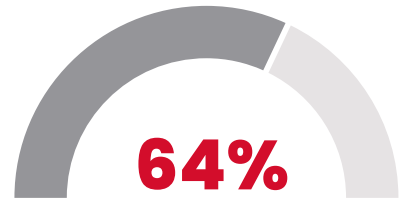


# The true cost of an empty truck
